# Who We Are

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- Our mission is "to improve the health and school performance of Rockingham County students by providing comprehensive health care through education, prevention, treatment, and referral."
- The health centers are located in each of the four high schools in Rockingham County: McMichael High School, Morehead High School, Reidsville High School and Rockingham County High School.
- The health centers are each staffed with a Physicians Assistant or Nurse Practitioner, Registered Nurse, Licensed Mental Health Provider, and Medical Clerk



# What We Provide

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- Physical exams - including sports, college, and camp
- Diagnosis and treatment of minor injuries and illnesses
- Chronic disease monitoring
- Immunizations
- Health education programs
- Laboratory tests
- Mental health assessments, counseling and referral
- Vision screening and referral
- Pregnancy testing and prenatal care referral
- Nutrition counseling and education
- Abuse and violence intervention and referral
- Dental screening and referral
- Medications, both over the counter and some prescription



# Benefits to Using the Student Health Center

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- Students can access routine medical care while they are at school, no need to leave school for routine medical needs. Health providers at the student health center are able to diagnose and treat minor injuries and illnesses such as colds, headaches, sore throats and other common complaints.
- Physicals, immunizations, and well child appointments can be met within the student health center, minimizing parents' time away from work and students' time away from school and academic instruction.



# Accessing the Student Health Center

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- Students can access the Student Health Center during school hours, Mon-Fri 7:30am-4:00pm. Staff are available for walk in appointments as well as scheduled appointments. We coordinate with school staff to see students during times that will provide the least interruption possible to academic instruction.
- **All student must have a consent form on file to access any services at the Student Health Center.**



# Student Health Center Consent

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- In order for your child to receive services at any of the Rockingham County Student Health Centers, a parent consent form must be filled out and signed as well as a brief medical history form.
